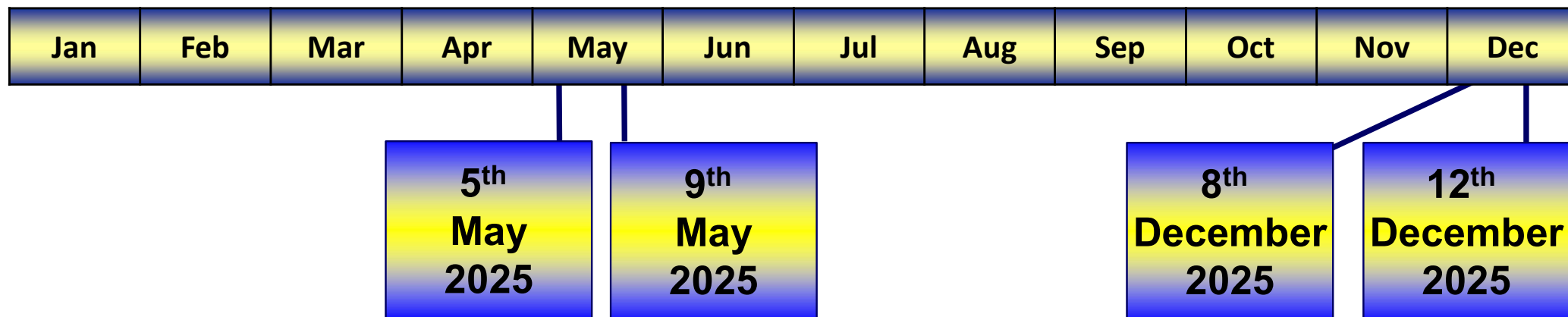

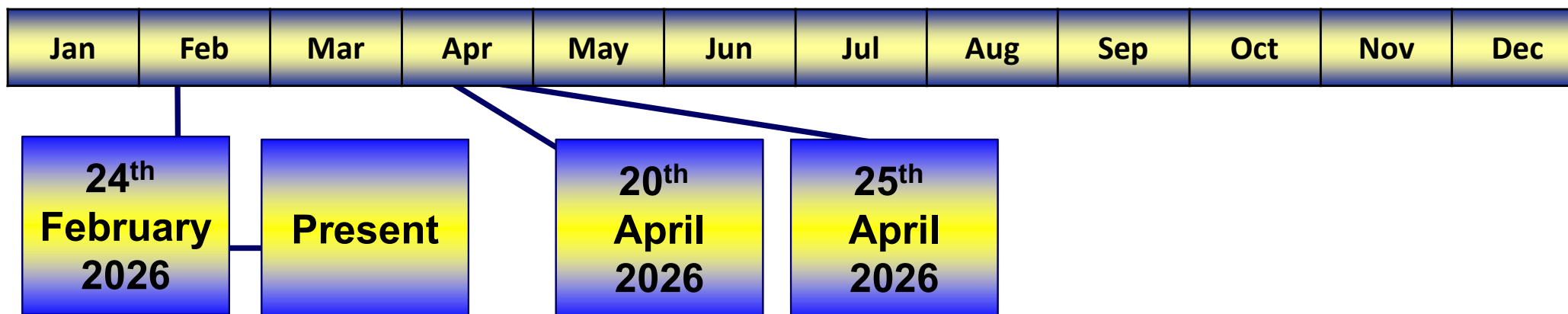

1. BIP CSDP – Turin, Italy

My first Erasmus experience was a Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) in Turin, Italy, focused on the Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP). The programme improved my understanding of NATO, the European Union, and international cooperation in the security field.



2. CM Cross Cultural Communication – Zagreb, Croatia

My second Erasmus experience was a Common Module on Cross Cultural Communication in Zagreb, Croatia. As the only Romanian participant, I developed adaptability, communication skills, and the ability to work efficiently in an international environment.



3. Erasmus International Representative – Bucharest, Romania

My third Erasmus experience is currently ongoing at the Military Technical Academy “Ferdinand I”, where I serve as Erasmus International Representative. Together with my colleagues, we support incoming students, organize activities, and help them integrate into the academy community.



4. BIP Intercultural and Scientific Communication– Bucharest, Romania

For the first time, I was both a host for international participants and a co-organizer for the CERC 2026 student conference. Although the week was quite busy and challenging, I successfully managed all the activities, creating many new memories and friendships.
