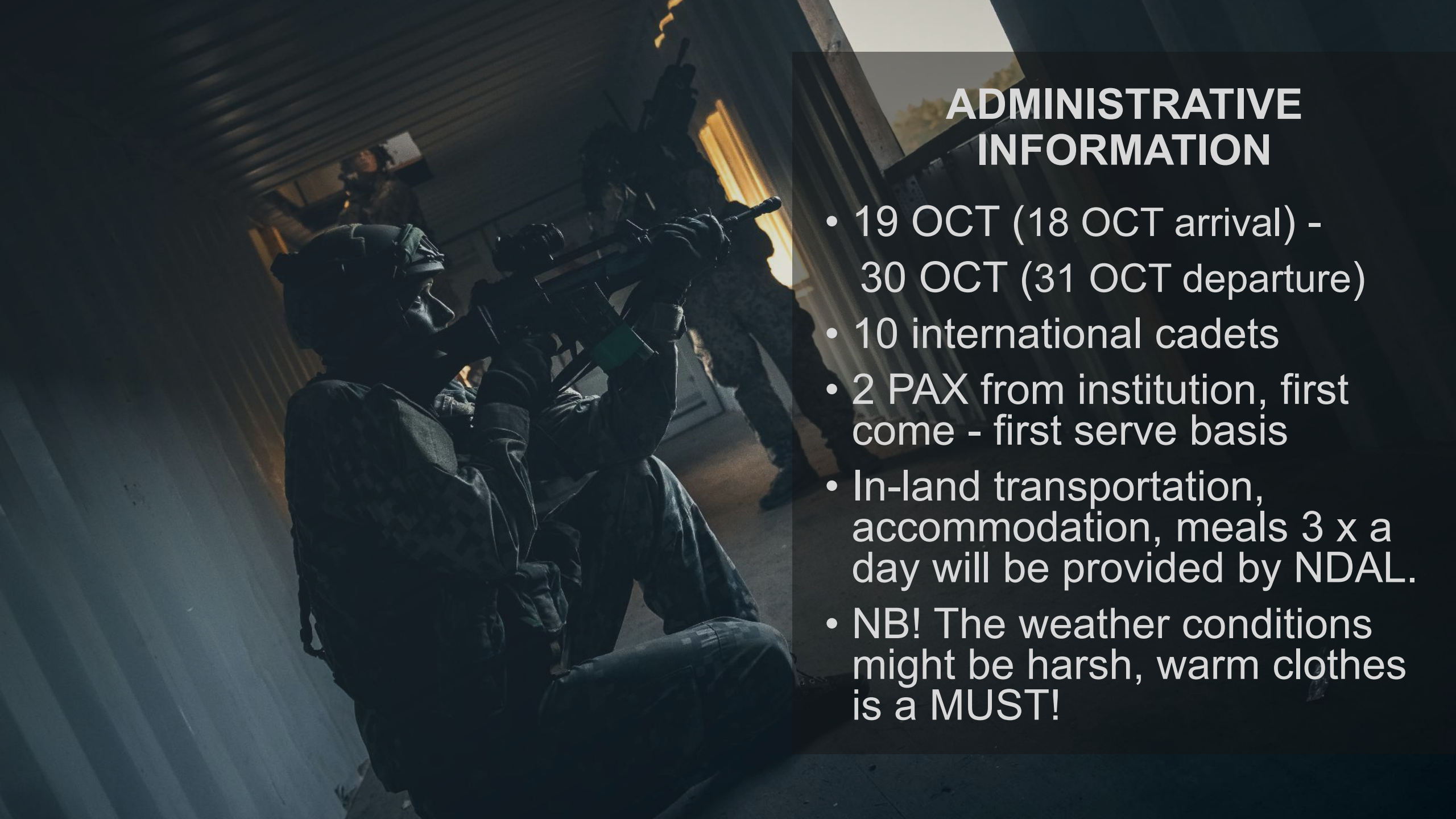


Fighting In Built Up Area (FIBUA)

observation

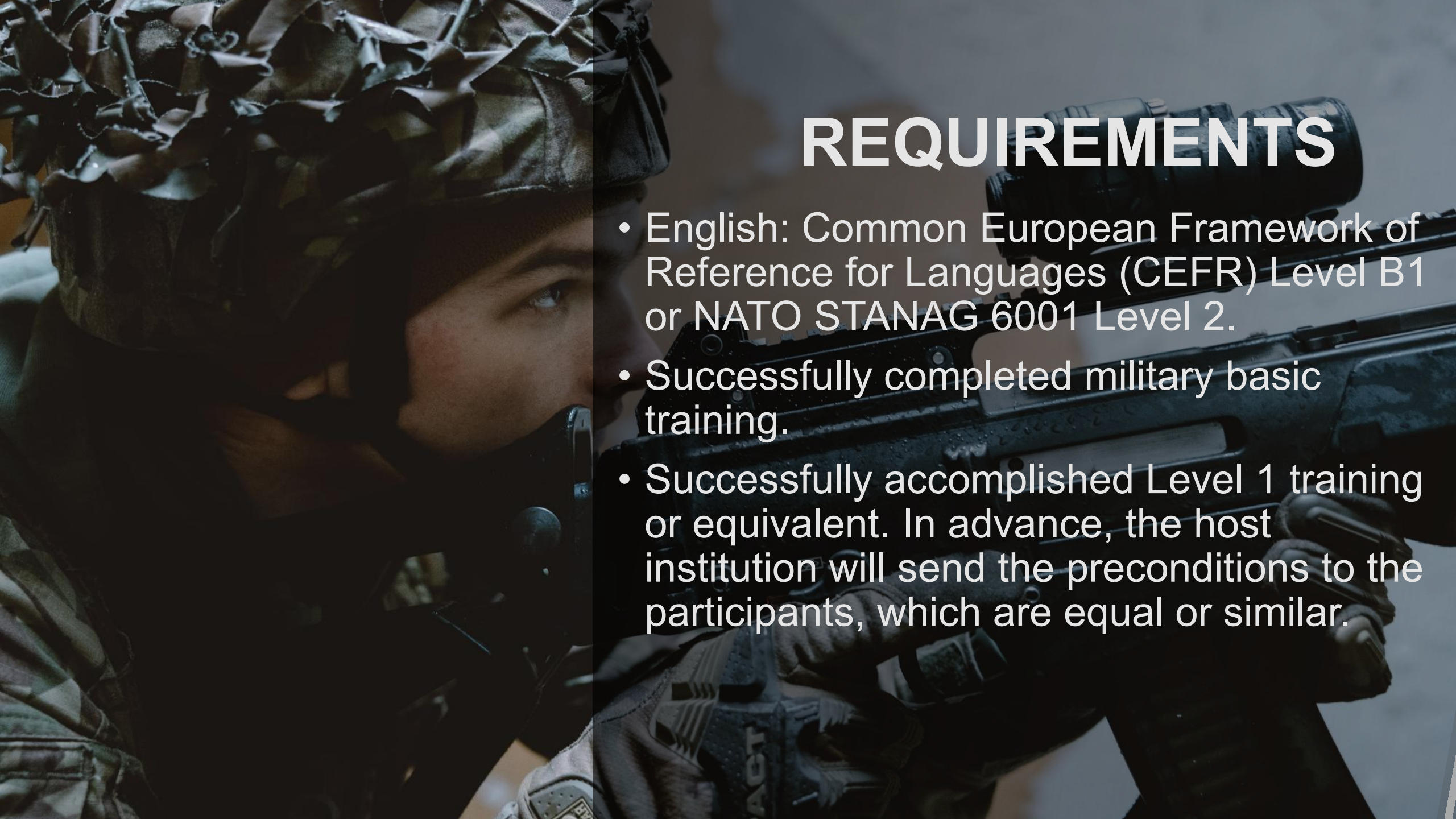
- Fulfil given tasks according to international regulations. During the training each cadet will be evaluated in order to verify the skills and the planning ability.

test
