Dear Commandants and Rectors,

I have the pleasure to invite your students to participate in the "*International Marine Basic Training Week*" under the framework of the European Initiative for the Exchange of Young Military Officers that will take place from the **05th to 16th of November 2025** conducted by the Spanish Naval Academy in *Parga* (Lugo).

We are delighted to host **four (4) international cadets in pairs of two (2)** from different Academies and provide the opportunity of experiencing six days of intense marine practical training in *Parga* together with our marine cadets.

To accomplish marine training week is required to have a minimum drill, knowledge and good shape to reach the two main phases:

Inprocessing phase (in Spanish Naval Academy):

- 1 day – Map reading and land navigation drill.
- 1 day – Logistic preparation and Marine training week briefing.

Main phase (in *Parga*, Lugo):

- **3 days - Individual Training**: Map reading and land navigation skills, live shooting, basic combat training, squad tactics and procedures.
- **2 days - Tactical Exercise**: Application of squad TTP's in a peer to peer tactical scenario – 36 hrs.

The detailed program will be issued on the previous week by email.

As for the logistics, accommodation and meals are provided free of charge as well as **transportation from/to Vigo (25 min.) or Santiago (60 min.) airport**.

The dates of **arrival/departure should be 04th/17th of November**. No participation fee is required.

The application form as well as the presentation of the event will be upload on the EMILYO website.
