(European initiative for the exchange of young military officers, inspired by Erasmus)

Organized in Athens/Greece from 29th September to 3rd October 2025

Admin Info

1. Participation

At the Common Module can participate cadets/students/young military officers with some previous basic knowledge about the European Union, its history and its structure. A good English level is required: Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) Level B1 or NATO STANAG Level 2.

A total number of 45 participants will be admitted as below:

- 10 National Civilian University Students in Strategic Sciences
- 15 National Corps Colleges Cadets/Young Military Officers
- 20 International Cadets/ Young Military Officers

The Module will be provided in English language.

2. Transportation

Participants are requested to make their own travel arrangements to and from Athens International Airport.

The Hellenic Air Force Academy will cover free transport from Athens International Airport “Eleftherios Venizelos” to the Academy and back additionally, as well as during the entire stay in Athens.

Therefore, participants are kindly requested to arrange their arrival to Athens International Airport on 28th of September 2025 NLT 18:00 and their departure on 3rd of October 2025 after 16:00 (if that is possible). You will be met at the Athens International Airport Arrival Hall according to your flight schedule by a representative from the Hellenic Air Force Academy who will hold “**HAFA CSDP**” logo.

3. Accommodation

Please be informed that the Hellenic Air Force Academy will provide housing for the participating International cadets / Young military officers at the Academy’s campus.

4. Meals

The Hellenic Air Force Academy will provide meals for the cadets who will be accommodated at HAFA premises (Military Personnel ONLY).

All students please take into consideration that the access to the server for IDL (e-learning phase) will be closed down on **Friday 27th of September 2025** (23:59 UTC).
