Common Module Crisis Management Operations is designed to provide cadets with an in-depth understanding of the principles and practical application of Crisis Management Operations at the squad and platoon levels. It aims to enhance their ability to plan, execute, coordinate, and control tactical tasks within CMO type operations in line with national doctrine.

Course Details:

Dates: **November 22, 2025** (arrival)–**December 6, 2025** (departure)

Location: **National Defence Academy of Latvia** and **Skrunda**, Latvia

Target Participants: 2nd or 3rd-year cadets with prior knowledge of section and platoon-level tactics.

Course Credits: 3 ECTS (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System)


Key Training Components include practical exercises involving the use of support elements in CMO, planning and coordination of platoon-level operations, and integration and supervision of combat support elements within CMO scenarios.

Logistics and Expenses: The National Defence Academy of Latvia will cover all **inland transportation, catering and accommodation** expenses for participating cadets throughout the module. Please note that cadets are required to bring their own **mandatory equipment** to participate in the module.
