Administrative Information

1. PARTICIPATION

Cadets, students and young military officers with basic prior knowledge of the European Union are eligible to participate.

A good level of English is required, corresponding to CEFR Level B1 or NATO STANAG Level 2.

2. TRANSPORTATION

Milan Bergamo Airport (Orio al Serio) is the recommended airport.

The Guardia di Finanza Academy is located 53 km from Milan Linate Airport and 92 km from Milan Malpensa Airport.

The Academy will provide free transportation between Milan Bergamo Airport (Orio al Serio) and the Academy, as well as transportation between Bergamo and Milan during the scheduled visit.

Arrival is recommended on 11th October 2026 and departure on the afternoon/evening of 16th October or on 17th October 2026.

3. ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

The Guardia di Finanza Academy will provide free accommodation and meals for participants and accompanying persons.
