The Guardia Civil is a law enforcement institution with a military nature founded in 1844. Since its foundation, the Institution has promoted its future leaders' education, and more recently with the integration in the European Higher Education Area (EHEA) through the creation of the Guardia Civil University Centre (CUGC) based in Aranjuez (Madrid).

The CUGC is providing EHEA accredited degrees at different levels and promoting with its internationalization strategy, staff and students Erasmus+ mobilities holding the Erasmus+ Charter for Higher Education since 2014, and the Vocational Educational and Training (VET) Erasmus+ Accreditation.
