Dear Rectors, dear Commandants,

the University of Defence has the privilege to organize the fifth reiteration of the “Intelligence Support to Operations” Course that will take place in Brno from 31<sup>st</sup> August to 18<sup>th</sup> September 2026. The main objective of the course is to provide students with an opportunity to receive training in practical execution of the intelligence cycle together with reconnaissance tasks at the tactical level of command and control within a realistic scenario.

In order to make this training event as authentic as possible, and to expand knowledge related to intelligence and intelligence, surveillance, reconnaissance (ISR) in the multinational environment, we are delighted to offer several positions for training audience from the EU and/or NATO member countries. Because of the capacity limitations we can welcome up to 20 international students with specialization in reconnaissance and intelligence.

The students will participate in both academic lectures conducted in Brno and live field training “Agile Cub 2026” which will take place in Libava Military Training Area. As all the activities will be conducted in English language, at least Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) Level B1+ or NATO STANAG Level 2 is required. Please find the details in the attached annexes.

The university offers free lodging and meals during the event. No participation fee is required. Transportation to/from Brno is under the participants responsibility, the University of Defence will provide transportation within the course agenda.

The Delegations and Visits Day in Libava Military Training Area on the 17<sup>th</sup> September 2026 will allow you to observe firsthand the dynamic learning environment we have created, meet the students, and interact with our academic staff. We believe that your attendance will not only enhance the experience for our participants but also serve as a valuable networking opportunity. We would be honoured if you could attend this event and share your valuable insights with participants of the activity as well as with other distinguished guests from all levels

of command and control of the Czech Armed Forces. Please let us know of your availability at your earliest convenience so we can make the necessary arrangements.
