1. Admin Info

1.1 Pre-conditions for Participation in the International Air Force Semester (IAFS):

- Only military **Officer Cadets** – with an appropriate military background – are foreseen to participate in the **entire** semester.
- The Officer Cadets' pre-conditions for participation in the entire International Semester are:
 - ✓ English language according to point 1.2.
 - ✓ Physical fitness standards as per own Institution requirements.
 - ✓ Basic managerial, communication and leadership competencies.
 - ✓ Basic negotiation and problem-solving skills.
 - ✓ Ability to plan, organize and accept responsibility.
 - ✓ Basic IT knowledge (e.g. Basic Office Suite skills).

1.2 Language:

- The entire International Semester is offered in the English language.
- The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) **Level B1 or NATO STANAG Level 2** is a requirement for participation.

1.3 Duration:



- The starting date is **the 28th of September 2026** and the last day is **the 18th of December 2026**.

1.4 Applications:

- Use the Application Form of **Annex 1** and send it to:

- Registration Deadline is the **31st of July 2026**
- Arrival is expected within the weekend before the start date (**28th of September 2026**), or the day before the module's start date (if one is to attend one or more specific Common Modules)
- Departure is expected on the End date and a case-to-case basis for participants attending one or more specific Common Module.
- All application forms will be prioritized on a “first-come/first-served” basis. Thus, you are kindly advised to submit your application timely.

1.5 Accommodation, Meals & Financial Info:

- According to EMILYO-LoD 5 (Framework), accommodation, meals, and other expenses concerning education are free of charge for members of European Union Basic Officer Education Institutions (<http://www.emilyo.eu/node/982>).
- No tuition fees are required.

1.6 Permission for Stay:

- Following the national regulations, the permission to stay shall be requested via the sending Institution's (military) diplomatic chain of command.
- A “Request for Visit (RfV)” is to be passed via the sending country's echelons to the respective country's embassy in Greece.

1.7 Transportation:

- All participants should make their travel arrangements.
- Transportation from Athens International Airport (ATH) to the Academy and vice versa will be provided by the Academy for all students/trainees. To that end, please notify the Hellenic Air Force



Academy's POC's concerning your flight information at your earliest convenience.

1.8 Uniform/Dress Code:

- In accordance with the dress code in effect within the Hellenic Air Force Academy, shorts and denim trousers are not allowed.
- The following attires conform with the Academy's uniform regulations:
 - ✓ Arrival/departure and short leave: Informal/Casual/Very casual
 - ✓ Opening/closing ceremony: Ceremonial Dress and Service Uniform
 - ✓ Courses: Working Dress uniform (with and without a tie) or Field Dress (dependent on the activity)
 - ✓ Sports activities: Own Academy shorts, t-shirt and tracksuit and swimming suit (for swimming training)

2. Content

2.1 Overview

- The entire International Air Force Semester (IAFS) has 24 ECTS and lasts more than three months. This fulfills the requirements for ERASMUS+ support.
- The IAFS consists of ten **(10) Common Modules; two (2) of them will be conducted within a weekly schedule**, and could be offered independently, with the participation of additional cadets (military or civilians).
