The Hellenic Air Force Academy under the auspices of the European Security and Defence College, in the framework of the European initiative for the exchange of young military officers, inspired by Erasmus, has the honour of organising a Common Module on Unmanned Aerial Systems.

The module consists of a **residential session**, held at Athens, at the premises of the Hellenic Air Force Academy in Dekeleia Air Force Base, **from the 20th to the 24th of April 2026**.

The module is based on the EMILYO Common Modules Standard Curriculum, which is the major component of EU training activities. The goals of the module are to provide the participants with a general overview of the basic principles of the technologies supporting Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS) and their applications, the specification and classification of different UAS categories, the technologies and challenges to counter malicious use of UAS types, and sensors used for civilian and military applications and the different perspectives for integrating UAS to CSDP missions.
