The Spanish Naval Academy has the pleasure and privilege to organize the 3th Common Module on Common Security and Defense Policy (CSDP) under the auspices of “European Initiative for the Exchange of Military Young Officers” Framework.

The module consists of a compulsory e-learning phase followed by a residential phase to be held in Marín (Spain) at the Spanish Naval Academy from **14-18 December 2026**. The major aim of this module is to provide the participants with a general overview on key civilian and military aspects of European Common Security and Defense Policy and is based on the EMILYO CSDP Standard Curriculum.

The international team of lecturers have significant experience in teaching in a multicultural environment and the students will participate in both formal academic lectures and syndicate work to enhance the learning experience. In order to enrich and diversify the learning environment and perspectives we count on up to 20 places for visiting students distributed among the different academies willing to participate.

The Spanish Naval Academy will provide accommodation, meals and transport for the students from/to Vigo (25 min.) or Santiago de Compostela (60 min.) airport.
