PRACTICAL INFORMATION

1.	Dates, Location, Participants
	<p>Participants are cadets/young officers who are willing to take part in the common module “Interoperability”. The module will take place in the period 09th-20th March 2026.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Basic knowledge on English (B2 level) or NATO STANAG Level 3▪ Basic managerial and leadership competences▪ Awareness of respective national armed forces (organization, mission), including basic knowledge of roles and capabilities of national military equipment and weapon systems <p>Up to 15-20 participants will be admitted. NOTE: The second week of the module (16-20 March) will be held at the Land Forces Combat Training Center “GETICA” in CINCUI.</p>
2.	Accommodation and meals
	<p>The participants who will choose to stay in the Academy's buildings will be offered accommodation and meals free of charge. Each room in the Academy can accommodate 2-3 persons.</p>
3.	Costs
	<p>Accommodation and meals are provided free of charge for all participants who decide to stay inside the Academy. No course fee is required.</p>
4.	Transportation
	<p>Participants are requested to make their own travel arrangements to and from Sibiu: airport/railway station/bus station etc. “Nicolae Bălcescu” Land Forces Academy will provide free transport from the above mentioned locations to the Academy and back. Transportation from/to local airport or railway stations must be required in advance, preferably one week before arrival. Prices for using taxis from the airport/railway station/bus station to the academy rate between 10-15 EUR. Another option is to use public transportation.</p>
5.	Uniform/dress code
	<p>Arrival/Departure/Sightseeing/Social events: Civilian clothes. Opening/Closing ceremony: Best dress uniform. Classes: Combat uniform/Service uniform.</p>
