### ADMIN DETAILS

#### 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

A CSDP course will take place at the Spanish Naval Academy (SNA) in Marín, Spain. The participants are expected to arrive on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> December 2026 and depart 18<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> December 2026.

#### 3. TRANSPORTATION

Participants are requested to make their own travel arrangements to and from Vigo (nearest one) or Santiago airport.

##### 3.1 Arrival

Delegations should arrive on Sunday, 12<sup>th</sup> - 13<sup>th</sup> December 2026 by air at the Vigo or Santiago Airport or by train at the Pontevedra Train station.

Delegations will be greeted by midshipmen from the Spanish Naval Academy who will be in uniform at the airport/train station.

Pickup will be coordinated based on arrival time via a WhatsApp group established by designated students who will greet participants upon arrival at the airport/train station.

##### 3.2 Departure

Delegations should leave no later than Thursday, 18<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> December 2026.

Dropoff will be coordinated based on departure time via a WhatsApp group established by designated students to the airport/train station for departure.

SNA will provide transportation throughout the week for every activity.



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## 4. ACCOMODATION

Cadets will be accommodated for free on base at the Spanish Naval Academy. Students will stay with Spanish cadets, sharing their dorms, at the SNA premises.

## 5. MEALS

The SNA will provide meals free of charge for the students during the week at the dining facility **on base**.

**The SNA will offer an official dinner (dress code: business casual, jacket without tie). Students willing to take part in this activity please mark the option in Form.**

## 6. DRESS CODE

- Monday to Thursday: It will be in working military attire (military personnel only) or business casual (jacket without tie) (for civilian personnel).
- Official Dinner: Business casual for all (no uniform required).

## 7. ACCESS TO THE BASE / COMMUNICATION

- All international cadets will be added to a WhatsApp group using the phone numbers provided on the registration form so you can be in routine contact with the group and local Spanish POCs. The group will be managed by one of the Spanish Students.

## 8. MISCELLANEOUS
