<b>Event:</b> <i>International Air Force Cadet's Week</i>
<b>Date:</b> 19th – 25th April 2026
<b>Length:</b> 7 days
<b>Host Institution:</b> Polish Air Force University (PAFU)
<p><b>Participants:</b>  Military Academies/Universities from all EU member states (up to 2 cadets + 1 Escort Officer per institution). Moreover, the invitation will be also sent to the institutions outside the EU, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- RAF College Cranwell, United Kingdom;</li> <li>- Republic of Korea Air Force Academy, Republic of Korea;</li> <li>- US Air Force Academy, USA;</li> <li>- Ivan Kozhedub National Air Force University, Ukraine;</li> <li>- National Defence University, Azarbaijan;</li> <li>- Armenia's Military Academy, Armenia</li> </ul>
<b>Number of participants:</b> Due to the limited numbers of possible participants, first come first served rule applies.
<b>Event content:</b> The event is mainly intended for cadets and escort officers from the air force. The event is aimed at familiarising participants with the PAFU history, its education and training process, as well as its training facilities. The participants will have the possibility to exchange knowledge and experience with other participants of the event in terms of military education and training. The event will also be a great opportunity to get acquainted with the Polish culture.
<b>Mode:</b> lectures, practical classes, visiting PAFU and other chosen nearby military units, sports activities, cultural and social events, sightseeing including local tourist attractions.
<b>Effects:</b> Certificate of attendance for participants will be issued and provided by the PAFU once the event is finished.
<b>Language of instruction:</b> English
<b>Dress code:</b> Participants are expected to wear a combat dress uniform for all seminars, workshops and field activities. Official dress uniform is required for an official meeting with the Commandant. Civilian clothes are to be worn outside working hours, for trips, during free time and outside of the University. For sports activities, according to the agenda of the event, sports clothes are required.
<b>Accommodation:</b> at the PAFU premises, free of charge, provided by the host institution – PAFU.
<b>Meals:</b> at the PAFU premises, free of charge, provided by the host institution – PAFU.

**Transportation:** Participants are requested to make their own travel arrangements to and from Warsaw. All delegations are kindly asked to arrive at Warsaw Chopin airport. PAFU will provide free transfer from/ to Warsaw Chopin airport.

**Costs:** No participation fee is required for the activities held during the *International Air Force Cadet's Week*. Accommodation, meals and tourist attractions will be free of charge during the event, provided by the PAFU.
